Students will receive a \$15,000 scholarship to be used in the first academic year and can assume a part-time internship in their first academic quarter and thereafter subject to satisfactory performance. There is also the possibility of working full-time in the first summer quarter of the program.

The Redapt Scholarship will be used to improve the diversity of the MSBA program. Elements of diversity include, but are not limited to, those who are first in their family to attend college; those who have overcome substantial educational or economic obstacles; or those who have experienced living or working in diverse environments.

Applicants will be reviewed based on their quality of essay, academic success, and need level. Essay Prompt: Please explain how you would improve the diversity of the MSBA program. Elements of diversity include, but are not limited to: those who are first in their family to attend college; those who have overcome substantial educational or economic obstacles; or those who have experienced living or working in diverse environments. Responses should be no more than 250 words.
